Cancer Registrars Training Course

- Program description

As part of its commitment to advance knowledge, the Cancer Registry / Office of Scientific Affairs and Research at King Hussein Cancer Center is pleased to offer its first Cancer Registrars Training Course.

This course is designed on three phases:

Home-Preparation whereby the trainees will receive certain documents to read and an evaluation will be done for each document.

Class Work: The usual lectures given in class by professional Certified Tumor Registrars

Hands-on Training: Complete case abstraction will be held at the end of the course

- Goals and objectives

Upon successful completion of the course, the cancer registrar shall have an in-depth understanding of cancer registry importance, functions, and operations to be able to professionally abstract cancer cases and participate in the process of cancer control and research.
